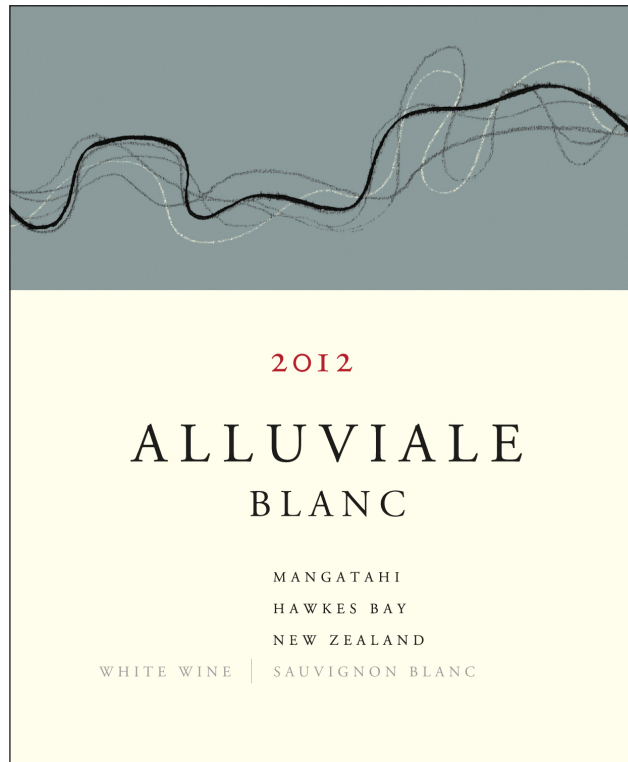

- Grape Varieties:** Sauvignon Blanc 98%, Semillon 2%
- Region:** Hawkes Bay, New Zealand.
- Vineyards:** The grapes for Alluviale Blanc are grown on the free draining, elevated river terraces on the banks of the Ngaruroro River and a selected Bridge Pa triangle site. These areas were chosen as the cooler temperatures experienced here result in a longer growing season, optimum for the production of premium Sauvignon Blanc.
- Color:** Gold with a pale straw hue.
- Bouquet:** Complex and fragrant. Mango, lime zest, grapefruit and gardenia aromas combine with boxwood, flint and mineral notes.
- Palate:** Lime cordial, melon, slate and cinnamon. The rich, concentrated flavours of this wine are accompanied by a crisp, lingering acidity.
- General:** A vibrant and fragrant wine combining fresh fruit flavours, mineral notes and subtle, spicy oak with a rich texture and well-balanced acidity.
- Production:** 500 cases produced.
- Cellaring:** Enjoy now or cellar confidently for 1-5 years.
- Technical Notes:** 13.0% alc/vol. pH: 3.36 TA: 7.80 g/L, RS<2g/L
- Serve:** Although perfect with lighter dishes, the full texture and crisp acidity mean it can be equally enjoyed with rich seafood or white meat dishes.
